

Your Very Own “Untitled”

You will need: a skinny, black marker; a set of colored pencils; a sheet of paper, and a ruler.

Using the ruler and a black colored pencil:

1. Make a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch border around the entire sheet of paper.
2. Make 5 angled lines, top to bottom.
3. Make 8 angled lines, side to side.

Using the colored pencils:

4. Color in 14 squares, heavily. Nothing else gets added to these squares.

Using the ruler and skinny, black marker:

5. Divide 15 squares from corner to corner, creating triangles.
6. In one more square, make an x from corner to corner.
7. Draw 5 tiny ladders in any of the blank squares.
8. Draw 11 tiny, black squares or rectangles floating and 11 tiny, black squares or rectangles touching a line.
9. Draw 2 triangles of any size floating and 5 triangles tucked into corners.

Keep using the ruler and black marker. Here is where it gets tricky!

10. Draw 5 individual (1) stripes; 7 sets of double (2) stripes; 7 sets of triple (3) stripes; 2 sets of quadruple (4) stripes and 1 set of quintuple (5) stripes! WHEW!

Using the skinny, black marker:

11. Draw 3 tiny, floating circles.
12. Draw one unusual shape in any non-colored squared.
13. Draw one unusual shape twice in the same square.

You are almost there! Using the colored pencils:

14. Lightly color in all the non-colored squares. These should look much lighter than the earlier squares you colored.

That's it! You now have your very own “*Untitled*” in the style of Kandinsky’s “*Untitled, 1930.*”
